You may be eligible for:

- ◆ **Post Aid Services**
 - Continue to receive supportive services for 12 months
 - Transitional Childcare for 24 months

Sanctioned: Call 408-758-3500 to inquire about lifting sanction process.

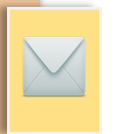
